for Surface Water Treatment Technique Violation

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) sets minimum water quality standards for public drinking water. [These standards include enforceable treatment technique requirements for drinking water. Inadequately treated water may contain disease-causing organisms. These organisms include bacteria, viruses, and parasites that can cause symptoms such as nausea, cramps, diarrhea, and associated headaches.]

CITY OF THREE RIVERS, PWS ID TX1490002, failed to meet the minimum treatment technique requirements for the month of FEB 2021. Specifically, our water system had Low disinfectant (Total Chlorine) residual entering the distribution system for more than four consecutive hours.

The City of Three Rivers has taken the following corrective actions to prevent a recurrence of the violation. We have installed heaters and winter blankets to keep the chlorine from freezing.
