In accordance with Section 551.041 of the Government Code, notice is hereby given that a **Emergency Meeting** of the City Council of the City of Three Rivers, Texas will be held on the **18th day of March 2020, at 2:00 p.m. at City Hall, 105 N. Harborth Ave., Three Rivers, Texas 78071.**

1. Call to order and quorum check.
2. Opening Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
3. Consider, discuss and take action on Emergency Ordinance No. 2322 of the City of Three Rivers, Texas extending a local state of disaster declaration due to a public health emergency for thirty (30) calendar days from date of ordinance. **(Mayor Felipe Q. Martinez)**
4. Consider, discuss and take action on Emergency Ordinance No. 2323 instituting emergency measures due to a local state of disaster due to a public health emergency to limit the number of persons gathering at restaurants and bars located within the City to business employees plus no more than fifteen (15) persons, and a penalty provided herein. **(Mayor Felipe Q. Martinez)**

The urgency of these item is that on March 13, 2020, the Governor of the State of Texas declared a state of disaster and the President of the United States of America declared a national emergency in relation to COVID-19. On March 16, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Three Rivers issued a local emergency declaration. On March 14, the President of the United States held an additional press conference relating to COVID-19, and on March 15, 2020, the CDC issued additional guidance in relation to the same. Due to the rapidly evolving nature of the disease and emerging federal and state guidance, it is necessary that the City Council of Three Rivers consider and take action on emergency ordinances.

5. Adjournment

A closed executive session may be held if the discussion of any of the above agenda items concerns one of the following:



| 1. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.071 | Contemplated or pending litigation or matters where legal advice is requested of the City Attorney. |

| 3. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.073 | A contract for a prospective gift or donation to the City, if the deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the City in negotiations with a third person. |
| 4. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.074 | Personnel matters involving the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint against an officer or employee. |
| 5. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.076 | The deployment or specific occasion for the implementation of security personnel or devices . |
