In accordance with Section 551.041 of the Government Code, notice is hereby given that an Emergency Meeting of the City Council of the City of Three Rivers, Texas will be held on the **25th day of March 2020, at 2:00 p.m. at City Hall, 105 N. Harborth Ave., Three Rivers, Texas 78071.** On March 13, 2020, the President of the United States of America declared a national emergency and the Governor of the State of Texas declared a state of disaster regarding COVID-19. On March 14, 2020, the President of the United States held an additional press conference relating to COVID-19, and on March 15, 2020, the CDC issued additional guidance regarding the same. On March 22, 2020, the Three Rivers City Council issued a local emergency declaration. Due to the rapidly evolving nature of the disease and emerging federal and state guidance, it is necessary that the City Council of the City of Three Rivers consider and take action on emergency ordinances.

1. Call to order and quorum check.
2. Opening Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
3. Consider, discuss and take action to adopt Ordinance No. 2323 to postpone the City of Three Rivers, Texas May 2, 2020 General Election to the November 3, 2020 Uniform Election Date. **(Mayor Felipe Q. Martinez)**
4. Update on operational and logistical measures related to the City's preparedness and response to the federal, state, and city's local state of emergency declaration due to a public health emergency known as COVID-19. **(Ray De Los Santos, SMMP and Thomas Salazar, City Administrator)**
5. Adjournment.



| 1. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.071 | Contemplated or pending litigation or matters where legal advice is requested of the City Attorney. |
| 2. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.072 | The purchase, exchange, lease or value or real property , if the deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the City in negotiations with a third person. |
| 3. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.073 | A contract for a prospective gift or donation to the City, if the deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the City in negotiations with a third person. |
| 4. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.074 | Personnel matters involving the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint against an officer or employee. |
| 5. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.076 | The deployment or specific occasion for the implementation of security personnel or devices . |
| 6. Texas Open Meetings Act - Section 551.087 | Deliberations regarding economic development negotiations . |
