



## **CITY OF THREE RIVERS, TEXAS NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Three Rivers City Council will conduct a public hearing to hear comments for and against the development of concrete and other trails, lighting, fencing, ball fields, courts, pavilions, playgrounds, water features, signage, landscaping, restrooms, parking, parking lot extensions, general park improvements, and submitting associated grant applications to Texas Parks & Wildlife Department.

Many of these improvements may be located in Kopplin Park, which is:

- (1) located within the city limits of the City of Three Rivers; and
- (2) located within the 100-year floodplain/wetland area according to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Maps.

Said proposed development may have certain environmental impacts on that floodplain/wetland area.
